The Conference will include:

1. Plenary reports (20 minutes) and discussion (5 minutes).

2. Session reports (10 minutes) and discussion (5 minutes).

3. Poster reports.

The Conference official languages – Russian, English.

Materials of the Conference will be published in the Book of Abstracts by the beginning of the Conference. Corresponding participants will receive the materials by post upon termination of the Conference. The abstracts should not exceed 2 pages.

Registration fee for materials publication and organization expenses equals **2000 Rubles;** for graduate and postgraduate students - **1000 Rubles**. Correspondent participation (abstract publication only) - **700 Rubles**.

Each author may submit no more than two abstracts. The abstracts should contain new unpublished data related to the scientific program of the Conference. The Organizing committee retains the right to select the materials in compliance with the Conference topics. All the abstracts accepted by the Organizing committee will be published in **the author's edition**.

Thorough proofreading of the text is strongly recommended to eliminate any possible stylistic or spelling errors. The Organizing Committee shall not undertake scientific or technical editing of the papers. Should formatting requirements fail to be met, the abstracts might be rejected for technical reasons.

The Organizing Committee undertakes the responsibility to inform the authors on the receipt of all the electronic materials. If the author does not receive from the Organizing Committee a confirmation on the receipt of an electronic letter within 3 working days, the letter should be sent **again**.

Formatting requirements

The abstracts should be sent in ready-to-publish format. The papers should be sent as an attachment in ready-to-publish form. The text should be in doc, (Word 2003) or rtf format, 2 A4 pages maximum including figures and references. All the margins should equal 2.5 cm. Font Times New Roman, 12 pt. The title of the report (semi-bold type) in capital letters should be centered and followed by a blank line. Names and initials of the authors should be aligned right on the next line; the next line (1.5 interval) should contain the name of the institution, city, e-mail, then in 2 intervals the singe-spaced text (new paragraph 1 cm, automatic hyphenation; no page headers/footers, no page numbers; the text should be justified). The next line is blank, the following line contains the word References. References in alphabetic order begin on the next line; in the text references are presented in square brackets [surname, year].

Illustrations (figures, pictures) should be of high quality, distinct, easy-to-see, black and white (not colored). The figure should consist of one layer. The illustrations should not exceed 15x15 cm and should be sent as a separate file in jpg format, minimum resolution 300 dpi. Legends to figures are to be highlighted in semi-bold type (11 pt, Times New Roman). The tables should have 11 pt Times New

Roman font. Legends to tables are also to be highlighted in semi-bold type, cumbersome tables are not recommended.
